

## COUNCIL CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

### CITY OF GARFIELD HEIGHTS, OHIO

Monday, October 22, 2012

President of Council Nancy Marincic called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

All Council Members were present.

The Chairman said that she would offer the invocation and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no communications.

Clmn Suster would handle the Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of 10/08/2012.

Clwn Mahoney moved to accept the Caucus Meeting Minutes of 10/08/2012 as submitted and the Minutes stood approved by a vote of 6 Yes (Mahoney, Vaughn, Marincic, Nenadovich, Glenn, Suster) and 1 Absent (Dudley) votes.

There was no legislation coming out of Committee. There were no Committee reports.

Ordinance 79-2012: Clwn Marincic advised that she would move to consider by title.

Ordinance 80-2012: Clwn Mahoney advised that she would move to consider by title.

Ordinance 81-2012: Clmn Glenn advised that he would move to consider by title and to amend the title.

Clmn Dudley said that a representative of ESOP (Empowering and Strengthening Ohio's People) wished to speak about ways that ESOP could help out with underwater mortgages, etc. toward the end of the meeting. President Marincic approved. Secondly, the Councilman desired to see the names of Council Members plus that of the Mayor on signs indicating construction projects. The Council President advised him to see the City Engineer to arrange this. Finally, Mr. Dudley had researched the matter and found that Council had never taken a formal vote to select the city flag design. He found that lacking. Clwn Mahoney suggested that the Law Department prepare a resolution regarding that. Clmn Dudley would follow up on that.

President Marincic said that Chief Sackett told her that a Garfield Heights policeman who will soon be deployed to Afghanistan would like to speak during the meeting and she approved. Mr. Riley pointed out that the speaker would address the audience rather than Council.

Clwn Mahoney requested permission to remind residents of the pit bull ordinance during miscellaneous comments because they have become an issue in Ward 6. Council approved. Clmn Dudley expressed concern over the pit bulls in Ward 1 also.

Clmn Nenadovich moved to adjourn the meeting and President Marincic declared the meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
