

## COUNCIL CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

### CITY OF GARFIELD HEIGHTS, OHIO

Monday, November 24, 2014

Council President Joseph Suster called the Caucus Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

All Council Members were present excepting Michael Nenadovich.

Clmn Burke moved to accept the Caucus Meeting Minutes of 11/10/2014 as submitted and the Minutes stood approved by a vote of 5 Yes (Burke, Vaughn, Marincic, Glenn, Suster) and 2 Absent (Dudley, Nenadovich) votes.

Clmn Burke would dispose of the Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of 11/10/2014 as presented.

Ordinance 67-2014: President Suster advised that he would move to consider by title.

Ordinance 68-2014: Clmn Vaughn advised that he would move to consider by title.

Ordinance 69-2014: Clwn Marincic advised that she would move to consider by title.

Ordinance 70-2014: Clwn Marincic advised that she would move to consider by title.

Resolution 19-2014: Clmn Burke advised that he would move to consider by title.

Resolution 20-2014: Clmn Vaughn advised that he would move to consider by title.

Clmn Burke would offer the invocation and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Council President recommended that Council pose questions to the Mayor and his Directors which pertained strictly to the content of their reports immediately following their reports. In addition, he said that the only residents allowed to speak would be those who had spoken to Council members or the Administration.

Clmn Dudley arrived.

Clmn Vaughn asked why a Ways & Means Committee Meeting had been scheduled for 12/10/2014. Clmn Glenn replied that the city needed money and it was to learn whether or not Council was interested in putting up a billboard. A discussion ensued as to the value of holding that meeting plus the Building Committee Meeting scheduled on the same date. Clmn Vaughn said he would call Clmn Nenadovich to find out whether or not he would hold his meeting. Clmn Glenn took a vote and asked how many Council members would favor a billboard if the conditions were right.

AYES: Glenn, Suster

Clmn Burke was in favor, but he preferred to speak with Ward 6 residents first. Councilpersons Dudley, Marincic and Vaughn voted to follow Clmn Burke's lead.

There were no communications to Council.

Clmn Burke moved to adjourn and the Caucus Meeting was adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
