

Welcome to our Municipal Figure Skating Program

The Garfield Heights Learn to Skate program follows the U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Program guidelines. The Basic Skills program is designed by U.S. Figure Skating to be the best beginning ice skating program that serves the needs of both recreational and competitive skaters.

We will have 3 structured sessions, pre-registration is required by the deadline of each session posted to avoid an additional \$15.00 fee.

All participants must purchase a Rec ID card. Resident ID is \$15.00 and Non-Resident is \$40.00. Residents need 2 proofs of residency (2 current utility bills or bank statement and paystub), please note we cannot use your drivers license for proof of residency, (unless renewed in the last 30 days) and a copy of the child's birth certificate is required for all registrations. The 6-week session fees are \$36.00 for Residents & \$60.00 Non-residents. All lessons include rental skates at no additional fee if needed. Registrations can only be done by a parent or legal guardian (guardian ship papers required at the time of registration)

Sessions

Session 1 – begins week of September 18– deadline Monday – September 17

Session 2 – begins week of October 30 – deadline Monday – October 29

Session 3 – begins week of January 8 – deadline Monday – January 7

Note: *no group lessons – Nov. 20, 22, 24, Dec. 18, 20, 22, 25, 29, Jan. 1, 3, 5*

During the weeks with no group lessons, private lesson time, walk on ice, and additional public sessions will be offered – times TBD

Skaters are encouraged to take private lessons, use walk on ice, and attend public sessions for extra practice. Punch cards are available for your convenience, by purchasing a punch card you get 2 free, or you can pay as you go.

Private “City Ice” Fees - \$5.00 pay as you go – or \$50.00 for 12 punches – 2 free

City ice is for the registered children in our Garfield Heights program for the above rate

However – a non-member can come & skate or have a lesson with outside pro of choice, or just practice at \$12.00 for the ice time

\$120.00 for a punch card with 2 free

\$10.00 Walk-on Ice – open to anyone – also pay as you go or purchase a punch card – get 2 free
