POOL OPENS SATURDAY – JUNE 10, 2017 at 1:00 PM



As in the past few years, the **office** at the Dan Kostel Recreation Center will be closed from May 8th through May 29th so we can prepare for our summer season. However we are here working & conducting business as usual, the doors are open for mail deliveries, product deliveries, visitors etc.

Beginning on Tuesday, May 30th the office will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm for your convenience to purchase season passes, ID cards, or register for our Learn to Swim program/sessions. The week of June 5th through June 9th our office will be open from 8:00 am – 7:00 pm for everyone's convenience to purchase passes etc. & avoid lines on opening day.

Residents

ID card - \$10.00 (allows entering pool for a reduced admission fee)

Season Passes - (no additional fees with seasons passes)

Student – \$30.00 – age 5 – 17

Adult - \$45.00 – age 18 – 59

Family Pass - \$90.00 – 2 parents 4 children

Additional dependent children residing in the household - \$10.00 each

Non-Residents

ID card - \$35.00 (allows entering pool for a reduced admission fee)

Season Passes – (no additional fees with seasons passes)

Student - \$150.00 – age 5 – 17

Adult - \$180.00 – age 18 – 59

Family Pass - \$360.00 – 2 parents 4 children

Additional dependent children in the residing in the household - \$10.00 each

Only a parent or legal guardian can purchase Passes, ID cards and register children for Learn to swim classes.

Birth certificates are required for all Season Pass, ID card purchases and all registrations. Residents need to bring 2 current utility bills, bank statements, pay stub for proof of residency, at the time of registration

No exceptions.

Learn To Swim Classes – 2 sessions offered

Session 1 – July 10th – July 20th deadline to register – **by July 7th – 4:00 pm**

7:15 pm – 7:45 pm – levels 1-6

Registration limited to 15 per class

Session 2 – July 24th – August 3rd deadline to register – **by July 21st 4:00 pm**

7:15 pm – 7:45 pm – levels 1-6

Registration limited to 15 per class

Lessons are held Monday through Thursday, for the 2 week session (8 lessons) Children must be 5 years of age to take the above lessons, birth certificate required at the time of registration. The Parks & Recreation Director reserves the right to cancel any classes with an enrollment of less than 6 participants however every attempt will be made to accommodate all participants by combining classes if necessary.

Fees for Learn to Swim Classes

Residents – 8 lessons = \$35.00 + \$10.00 current ID card
Non-Residents - 8 lessons = \$75.00 + \$35.00 current ID card

The Swimming Pool is open daily from 1:00 pm – 7:00 pm weather permitting and is also heated, so the water temperature is at a comfortable 80 degrees.
