DIVISIONS

- **A:** *ALL 7 YEAR OLDS ONLY* - must be age 7 on or before May 1, 2016 and must have 2 years experience in the Garfield Heights T-Ball program or ages 8-10 can register without any experience necessary and must be at least 8-17 by August 1, 2016.

A:-8 -10 years old

B: 11-13 years old

C: 14-17 years old

Ages 8-17 years on or before August 1, 2016

FEEES

- **RESIDENT:**
 $\$35.00 + \$10.00 = \$45.00$
Program fees and recreation ID card
- **Proof of Residency required at the time of registration – customer must bring 2 current utility bills**
- **NON-RESIDENT:**
 $\$65.00 + \$35.00 = \$100.00$
Program fees and recreation Id card
Birth Certificates required for all players.

We gladly accept all major credit cards, checks with drivers license, or cash for the city portion of fees.

- **ADDITIONAL BOOSTER CLUB**
PAYMENT OF \$25.00 FOR EACH PLAYER
(separate check due at the time of registration – **no cash please.**)
- **REGISTRATION: Begins Monday, March 28th through Friday, April 29th**
(no registrations on April 15, 16, & 17 the office will be closed due to annual ice show)
- \$15.00 fee for all *late registrations*, after April 29th no exceptions – all late registrations must be approved by the Parks and Recreation Director and will only be accepted if some team rosters are not full.
