POOL REGULATIONS

All children 12 and under MUST be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older AT ALL TIMES! No child under 12 years of age may be left at the pool unattended for any reason. NO SPECTATORS – EVERYONE MUST HAVE A VALID RECREATION ID CARD OR A SEASONS PASS TO ENTER OUR FACILITY. Please Note: Only an Adult with a recreation ID card, or season pass may bring in 1 guest for a fee of \$7.00. The adult must accompany the guest at the pool at all times, and not leave the premises. Parks and Recreation Director/Management reserve the right to refuse admission and/or eject from our facility those who may be under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or those exhibiting erratic behavior. Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. At the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Director, the facility may close due to inclement weather or low pool attendance with no rain checks/refunds due to the patron.
