

The Dan Kostel Recreation Center will be offering beginner swimming lessons this summer, Levels 1, 2, 3 & Adult. There will be 2 sessions held on Tuesdays & Thursdays for ages 5 & up, at 7:15 pm – 7:45 pm only.

Session 1 – June 21, 23, 28, 30, July 5, 7, 12, & 14

Session 2 – July 19, 21, 26, 28, Aug. 2, 4, 9, & 11

Registration will begin on Tuesday, May 31st
Deadline is June 17 for Session 1 & July 15 for Session 2 at 4:00 pm
or if class is filled up 1st before the deadline.

Due to staffing & scheduling you must sign up by the deadline, a \$15.00 administrative fee will be applied for all late registrations
if we accept late registrations.

Class sizes are limited to 10. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any classes due to lack of participation, however, every attempt will be made to accommodate all who have registered. Birth certificates mandatory at the time of registration, and child must be age 5.

Private lessons are also available – you must pre-register in advance at the office & pay city fees prior to scheduling a lesson, please inquire at the office and with the Head Lifeguard for details.

Fees: \$40.00 +\$15.00 ID card – Residents
\$80.00 + \$40.00 ID card – Non- Residents

GUIDE TO AQUATICS ACTIVITIES

Pool opens – Saturday, June 11th at 2:00 pm

All children 12 and under MUST be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older AT

ALL TIMES!! No child under 12 years of age may be left at the pool unattended for any reason. **NO SPECTATORS EVERYONE MUST HAVE AN ID CARD OR A SEASON PASS TO ENTER OUR FACILITY**
Please Note: Only an ADULT with a recreation ID card, or season pass may bring in 1 guest for a fee of \$7.00. The adult must accompany the guest at the pool at all times, and not leave the premises. Parks and Recreation Director/Management reserve the right to refuse admission and/or/eject from our facility those who may be under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or those exhibiting erratic behavior. Proper swim attire must be worn at all times. At the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Director, the facility may close due to inclement weather or low pool attendance with no rain checks/refunds due to the patron.

ID CARDS

ID Cards must be purchased for any lessons, or sport activity through the recreation department, per city ordinance, and will be good for any program that year, but not good for repeating a program the following season. Recreation ID Cards must be purchased by a parent or legal guardian, and TWO (2) proofs, 2 current utility bills, pay stub or bank statement must be brought in for each renewal please note we cannot use your drivers license for proof, unless it has been renewed within the last 30 days.

\$100.00– Family – 2 parents & 2 children under 18

NON-RESIDENTS

\$100.00 – Student individual – 5-17 years of age

\$120.00 – Adult individual - 18-64 years of age

\$240.00 – Family- 2 parents & 2 children under 18

Family Pass is limited to 4 members- 2 parents 2 dependent children living in household under age 18, \$10.00 each additional child 5-17 years of age *Does not include extended relatives, etc.**
