

## Welcome to our Learn to Skate Program

The Garfield Heights Learn to Skate program follows the U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Program guidelines. The Basic Skills program is designed by U.S. Figure Skating to be the best beginning ice skating program that serves the needs of both recreational and competitive skaters.

We will have 2 structured sessions this season, Monday evenings & Saturday afternoon - pre-registration is required by the deadline of each session posted to avoid an additional/administrative fee of \$15.00.

All participants must purchase a Rec ID card. Resident ID is \$15.00 and Non-Resident is \$40.00. Residents need 2 proofs of residency (2 current utility bills or bank statement and paystub), please note we cannot use your drivers license for proof of residency, (unless renewed in the last 30 days) and a copy of the child's birth certificate is required for all new registrations. The 6-week session fees are \$36.00 for Residents & \$60.00 Non-Residents. All lessons include rental skates at no additional fee if needed. Registration can only be done by a parent or legal guardian – guardianship papers required at the time of registration.

### Sessions

Session 1 – begins week of September 12 – deadline September 10

Session 2 – begins week of October 29 – deadline October 21

Session 3 – begins week of January 7 – deadline December 28

Session 4 – begins on February 18 – deadline February 10<sup>th</sup>

Thursdays will be added in Session 4 – for those who are registered for the Annual Ice Show only, time TBA.

Session 4 is only 5 weeks – fees will be adjusted accordingly

**Note: no lessons on Oct. 31, Nov. 22, 26, Dec. 19, 24, 27, 31,**

Private Lesson Times are posted to a separate flyer, these sessions are \$5.00 for members registered in our Learn to Skate program, \$10.00 for non-members. Skaters are encouraged to take private lessons, use walk on ice, attend public sessions, and take *advantage of our new ice on Saturdays from 11:00 am – 12:00 pm* – this is at no cost except for the family & friends who need skate rental (\$5.00) Punch cards are available for the private & walk on ice – save money by purchasing a punch card.

The flyer for the private lessons/walk on ice begins in September through December, a January through March schedule will be posted in early December these can be found on our web page & posted to the lobby bulletin board.
