



Equipment Operator: City of Garfield Heights

Job Summary:

Under general supervision of the Service Director and Service Foremen, the Equipment Operator performs a variety of semi-skilled work in the maintenance and/or repairs of streets and other public service activities and performs other work as required. Physical Agility Testing is a requirement as part of the Interview Process.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs repairing, patching and crack sealing of asphalt roads.
- Performs concrete work on roads and sidewalks.
- Work with tree crew, leaf pickup crew.
- Operate snow plows and snow removal equipment.
- Operator skid steer with various attachments.
- Perform sewer work (catch basins, storm drains, etc.).
- Operate a variety of hand and power tools.
- Follow policies, rules and regulations relating to the functions of the Department.
- Work in all weather conditions.
- Overtime as needed – including snow removal and other assignments as needed.

Qualifications:

- Minimum CDL Class B REQUIRED
- Knowledge and/or experience with Industrial snow plows and snow removal equipment, skid steer and various attachments, air compressor, jackhammer and concrete saws.
- Demonstrated experience in asphalt and concrete work.
- Ability to lift and carry 75 pounds or more.
- Physically able to perform job duties.
- Work in hot and cold temperatures for hours at a time.
