Garfield Heights Memorial Day tributes honoring our Deceased Veterans of all Wars and Conflicts will be held on Monday, May 31, 2021. There will be a vehicle parade followed by a private service at the Veterans Plaza at the Garfield Heights Civic Center, 5407 Turney Road. Social-distancing and mask-wearing protocols should be followed by all participants and observers to keep everyone safe.

The parade assembly will begin at 9:15 a.m., at Maple Leaf Elementary and Garfield Heights Middle schools, located at Maple Leaf Drive and Turney Road. The parade will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. Participants will drive the parade route on Turney Road and to Jennings and the Village at Marymount senior living centers. The parade will conclude at the Garfield Heights Civic Center, where services will be held. All participants are asked to stay in or near their cars for the live streaming of the ceremony. We ask, for safety reasons, that only Veterans and participants in the ceremony come to the Veterans Plaza.

The parade committee reminds everyone this is NOT a political event. The passing of literature and candy is prohibited. The parade is being organized by a citizen committee with the support of the city.
