


SHARE Protects Riders and Drivers


COVID-19 RESPONSE PLAN


SHARE is responding aggressively to COVID-19 with increased health and safety measures for riders and drivers. SHARE is setting the standard for safe, shared transportation.

State governments recommend employers offer stipends for private transportation to limit contact with possible carriers of Covid-19. This leaves many companies wondering how they can support their employees with their transition back to work. This is how SHARE is helping companies do it safely.

- ### Contact Tracing & Spacing
- Trace and monitor all riders and personnel using shared vehicles
 - Temperature checks for all drivers
 - All riders identified prior to accessing SHARE vehicles
 - Reduced riders per vehicle by 50%

- 
- ### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) & Support
- Gloves and face masks for drivers
 - Optional face masks provided to riders
 - Paid sick leave for drivers

- ### Vehicle Cleaning
- Controlled vehicle fleet
 - Deep cleaning before each ride
 - CDC recommended disinfectants
 - Vehicle rotation to prevent cross-contamination
