







The Garfield Heights Municipal Hockey and Municipal Figure Skating Programs invite you to an introduction to the sport of ice skating. Garfield Heights has the most affordable fees for any of our ice skating programs.

Your child must learn how to skate first, and pass Basic 1 & 2, and have an introduction to the sport of ice skating in any of our beginner learn to skate programs. We also have lessons on Tuesday and Thursday for beginners. See additional flyers for details.

Session 4 – Feb. 20, 27, March 6, 13, 20 (deadline Feb. 12th)

Session 4 is only 5 weeks fees will be adjusted accordingly

Register on or before set deadlines, to avoid an additional administrative fee of \$15.00



Registration will begin on Monday, July 6th through Monday, August 3rd deadline (*for past players*) during open office hours. Please note, our office hours will be limited due to COVID-19 closures & restrictions this summer.

For your convenience, you can call & pay all registration fees by phone, however, you will be responsible to fill all proper registration forms prior to your child going on the ice.

Please register your child early and avoid the late fee of an additional \$15.00 (for all past players –no exceptions). We encourage all registrations to be done in a timely manner for proper team scheduling.

No late fee applied for new hockey players.Your child must be registered prior to taking the ice.

If your child comes to practice & is not registered, there will be a \$10.00 non-refundable walk on fee, each time they go on the ice & up until they are registered.

Avoid all additional fees & register early.

Due to the COVID-19 closure of the pool this season, we cannot offer convenient evening and weekend office hours, as in the past. Pay registration fees early by the deadline and avoid the late fee of \$15.00

Deadline for travel hockey past players is August 3rd without a late fee.

ALL PLAYERS must check in at the office before taking the ice—if your child is not registered but wishes to practice a <u>non-refundable \$10.00 walk-on fee</u> will be required for each time they practice and take the ice, up until they are properly registered by parent or legal guardian.
