

## **WELCOME TO OUR MUNICIPAL ICESKATING LESSONS**

The Garfield Heights Learn to Skate program follows the U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Program guidelines. The Basic Skills program is designed by U.S. Figure Skating to be the best beginning ice skating program that serves the needs of both recreational and competitive skaters.

### **First Day Information**

Skaters should arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled class and announce their name at the front desk. Attendance will be taken every visit. Your child should wear thin socks as the skates should fit and be tied snugly. Proper attire could include sweatshirts, comfortable pants, gloves and a hat. No skirts are permitted without tights. Helmets are welcomed but not mandatory. Even though some guidelines have been lifted due to COVID 19, it is recommended *your child comes dressed to the rink*. There will be 4 Sessions this season, classes are held on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

### **Private Lessons & Walk-On Ice**

Private "city ice" lesson times are on Tuesdays and Thursdays & some additional sessions may be added. We will also offer \$10.00 Walk -on ice – this ice is for everyone – We welcome all skaters from other rinks to join us on these sessions. Monthly schedules will be posted to the web page, lobby bulletin boards, follow us on facebook for last minute changes, or call. All private & walk on ice is subject to change due to lack of participation. Members in any of our group lessons pay \$5.00 per private lesson on city ice non-members pay \$12.00. Punch cards are available for your convenience at the office, as well as \$10.00 walk on ice punch cards.

Residents - \$36.00 per 6 week Session + current \$15.00 Recreation ID card

Non-Residents - \$60.00 per 6 week Session + current \$40.00 Recreation ID card
